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What to Bring

Required items:

- Shotgun (break open, semiautomatic, or pump action)
- 100 rounds of ammunition
 - Shot size: 7.5, 8, or 9
 - Velocity not to exceed 1300 fps
- Eye protection
- Hearing protection
- Closed-toe shoes (**mandatory**)

Recommended items:

- Water

There is shelter available at the shotgun range, but sun exposure is still possible. Please wear comfortable outdoor clothing.

Class Day Schedule

Morning Session (9:00 AM – 12:00 PM)

Designed for participants with limited shotgun experience, the morning session helps shooters build confidence and comfort with their firearm before heading to the range.

Topics covered include:

- Shotgun types
- Choke tubes and use
- Ammunition selection and use
- Safe firearm handling
- Proper gun fit
- Shooting fundamentals and technique

Lunch Break: 12:00 PM – 1:00 PM

Lunch will be provided by **Sandhills Pointing Breeds Club**.

Afternoon Session (1:00 PM – 4:30 PM)

The afternoon session takes place entirely on the range, where participants practice wing-shooting skills with experienced coaches and clay targets that simulate real-world bird movement.

Additional topics include:

- Wing shooting style and technique
- Bird flight styles
- Follow up shots
- Hunting with dogs
- Shooting safely over dogs
- Additional dog-related hunting safety considerations

- Both the morning and afternoon sessions, or
- The afternoon session only
