No motorized vehicles allowed on course other than those designated for the bird planter, dog wagon, or handlers with written AKC accommodation. AKC walking field trial judges can use ATVs or UTVs if necessary.

All stakes will be walking on a single course without a bird field. Bobwhite quail will be released in all stakes except puppy stakes. Native game birds may be present in all stakes. No blank pistol firing in puppy stake. We will have a gallery wagon. Spectators welcome!
