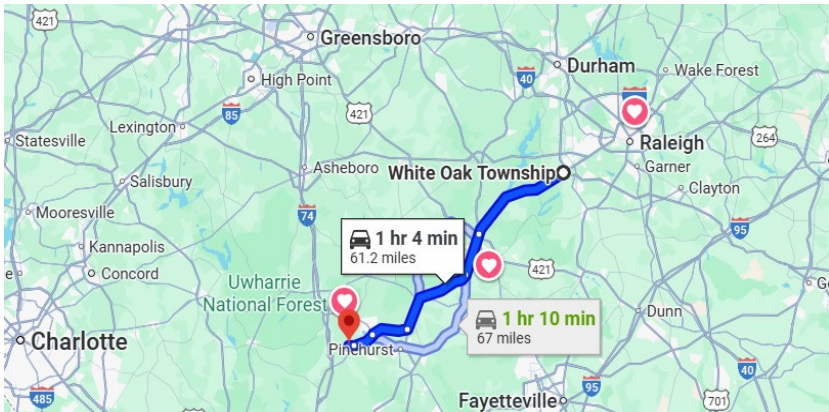

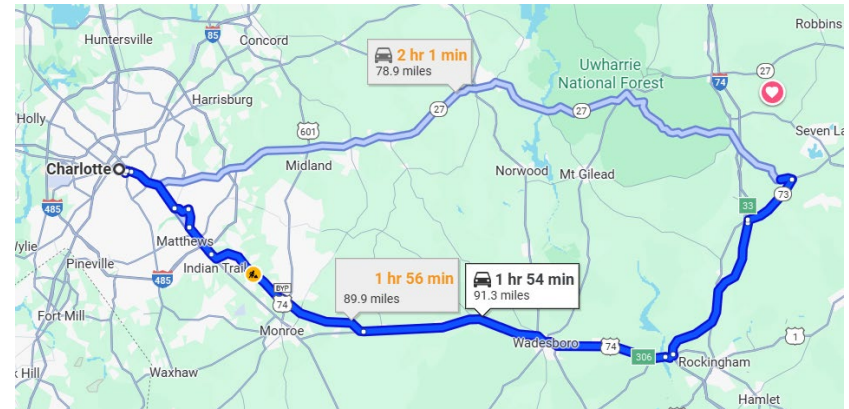
Follow U.S. Rte 1 S and US-15 S/US-501 S to NC-73 W in Moore County

- ↗ Merge onto US-74 E/E Independence Blvd/E Independence Fwy 6.1 mi
- ↙ Turn left onto Margaret Wallace Rd 1.6 mi
- ↘ Turn right onto Sam Newell Rd 1.9 mi
- ↙ Turn left onto US-74 E/E Independence Blvd/E Independence Fwy 3.6 mi
- ↙ Keep left to continue on US-74 BYP **Toll road** 18.6 mi
- ↑ Continue onto US-74 E 31.8 mi
- ↗ Slight right onto the US-74 BUS ramp to Rockingham 0.9 mi
- ↗ Slight right to merge onto I-73/I-74 17.2 mi
- ↘ Take exit 33 for NC-73 0.3 mi
